



Playground Project Summary

Playground Construction at SDN Keling Primary School

Keling Village, East Lombok, Indonesia

SDN Keling Primary School serves children from Grade 1 through Grade 6 in the rural communities of Keling, Kesambik, Jowet Timur, Jowet Barat, Serero, and Modak in East Lombok, Indonesia.

The school currently serves 180 students taught by 13 teachers and supports families from several surrounding villages. The nearby community of Keling consists of approximately 60 families and 67 children, many of whom attend SDN Keling.



The school currently has no playground equipment or recreational facilities for its students. During breaks and after classes, children have limited opportunities for physical activity, social interaction, and outdoor play.

This project will create the school's first dedicated playground area, providing a safe and enjoyable environment for exercise, creativity, and childhood development.

Planned Playground Equipment:

- One children's slide
- One monkey bar set
- One three-seat swing set
- One horizontal bar fitness and play set



These facilities will encourage physical fitness, coordination, teamwork, confidence, and healthy outdoor activity for children between the ages of

approximately 6 and 12 years old.
