



Partner Profile Action for Change



Founded in 2012 by volunteers and then later registered as a nonprofit in 2015, Action for Change (AFC) is located in Buea. The area where they work is called the Ndongo community, which is a typical slum where more than 95% of households live below the UN poverty line. The community has a growing population of over 7,000 inhabitants who are poor peasant farmers with very low income. Women and children constitute a greater majority of the population.

AFC strives to: reduce poverty by promoting sustainable livelihood initiatives; encourage gender equality by promoting the rights of women and girls; promote the development and growth of education in poor and disadvantage communities; promote hygiene and sanitation in schools and communities; sensitize communities on the danger of environmental destruction; promote prevention of HIV/AIDS among adolescent girls and young women.
