\* The school does not have any play equipment at all.

\* The large open yard has plenty of space for equipment.

\* The community is contributing 52% of the cost of the project (total cost is \$3,118). The Global Uplift Project has committed to raising \$1,500 (48%).

The Global Uplift Project, in partnership with the Little Sisters Fund, will help fund a playground to be installed at the Aankura English Secondary Boarding School, in Dharamghar. Currently, the school has a large open yard but no play equipment at all. The school has 423 students in grades 1-12 with 27 dedicated teaching staff. Research has shown that children who are allowed to play perform better academically, learn social skills, improve their creativity, and reduce stress.

The playground will include a slide, a swing, a seesaw, and a merry-go-round. All equipment will be made locally by a metal worker.
