Needs Assessment:

* The school does not currently have any science lab

* Grades 6-10 learn from books but have no way to do any hands-on training

* The community is contributing 60% of the cost of the project (total cost is \$1650; ODFL has committed to raising \$660 to help finish the project).



ODFL, in partnership with the Little Sisters Fund, will help equip a room at the Bhanu Sanskrit School in Tanahum to be used for practical science instruction. The school has 240 students in grades 1-10 with 18 dedicated teaching staff. The national science curriculum is taught in grades 6-10 to 200 students, but they have no facilities for practical lab work.

The room will be equipped with 20 different specimens (i.e., frogs, butterflies, octopus, leeches) chemicals, equipment (microscopes, hydrometer, lactometer, slides, etc.) as well as safety supplies (goggles, gloves, aprons).

Once the science lab is furnished, the students will be taught practical science through hands-on experiments. Currently, the students cannot compete to go on to higher education because they do not have any practical experience.
