GSM Uganda empowers people through education. They have educated over 6,000 students since their beginning in 1990, with over 1,500 children currently in Nursery, Primary or Secondary School programs.

GSM Uganda has over 300 students in orphan homes. These homes are able to provide a sense of family to many of these students. They provide housing and food for the students living on campus, medical, and life skills training.

GSM has many community impact programs including HIV/AIDS education; senior citizens programs; GOGO Piggery project (Get One, Give One); Community farming projects; Community Fishing projects; and Hospital Ministry.
