Project Summary:

Build 4 pit latrines and a washing station for girls at the school.

Project Detail:

The existing latrines are inadequate and at risk of collapse.

Kiini Sustainable Initiative (KISI). TGUP has completed more than a dozen major projects in partnership with KISI, including classrooms, latrines, playgrounds, etc.

TGUP, in partnership with Kiini Sustainable Initiative, will build 4 pit latrines for girls at the Githage School in rural Nyeri county. The existing 2 latrines for girls are at risk of collapse, are unsafe, and are unsanitary.

TGUP has previously funded many sets of latrines for other schools in the country. This project will include a new building comprised of 4 private latrines and a washing station dedicated solely for girls' use.

Currently, the girls end up having to wait in line to use other latrines, often causing them to be late for class. To compound the problem, there is no place for the girls to wash up afterwards, which is particularly troublesome when a girl has her period. She ends up skipping school altogether, leading to eventual drop out.
