

How Can Our Club Participate In the Div 12 6C Project?

CalNevHa Division 12 is building a classroom for the village of Luz de Cristo in Nicaragua. There are three ways Clubs and their members can participate.

- 1. **Individual donations made directly.** An individual can go to the <u>donation page for the project</u> and make an individual donation of any size. Or, they can send a check to TGUP directly. This is simple and easy. The downside is that the member's Club does not receive recognition for their donation.
- 2. **Individual donations made through the Club.** Here, individuals make donations through their Club. They write a check to the club, earmarked "Nicaragua Classroom." The treasurer or secretary adds up all the donations and sends an equivalent check to TGUP (address below). This way, the Club's contribution is able to be acknowledged.
- 3. **Club donations.** The Club, through its foundation, or International Service committee, makes a donation directly to the Project. This method allows every member of the Club to participate, and for the Club to get full recognition. This may be more difficult if the donation is not already budgeted.
