

Kahiraini Primary School.

The school was established in 1959. It is a public institution located in Gatunganga Sub-Location, Ngorano Location in Nyeri County. For decades, the school has served the surrounding communities of Gatunganga, Chieni B, Gatunai, Kiangonina, Kiandoini, and Kahiraini, becoming a key center of learning in the area.

With a current population of 302 learners, 130 girls and 172 boys, including children from special groups, the school remains committed to providing inclusive education and nurturing young minds despite the challenges it faces.

The school is supported by a dedicated team of 16 teachers employed by the Teachers Service Commission (TSC). While the school has adequate learning materials such as books, its physical facilities present significant challenges. There is a shortage of classrooms and desks, the condition of the toilets is poor, and the science laboratory is not well equipped. However, efforts have been made to improve infrastructure, including the ongoing renovation of the school hall.

Academically, Kahiraini Primary School records average performance, with great potential for improvement if key challenges are addressed. The most urgent needs include the construction of a well-equipped science laboratory and the addition of at least one classroom. These improvements would greatly enhance the teaching and learning of science subjects, including home science, ultimately boosting academic performance and providing learners with better opportunities for the future.
