TGUP, in partnership with KISI, will install electricity throughout the school. This is one of eight separate projects at the Kiahuko Primary School.

In addition to the electrical installation, a new 28'x28' classroom will be built, a new kitchen with two cooking jikos, a playground, water tanks installed on slabs and connected to rooftops with gutters, and two sets of latrines.

Enrollment has been limited due to the crumbling and lack of infrastructure. With these improvements, enrollment is expected to increase sharply in the next few years.

There is currently only electricity to the staffroom, and it is so old that it is dangerous to use. This project will replace the old wiring and install proper conduits throughout the entire school, including the new kitchen.

The project will cost \$2,275. Of this, \$200 is being contributed by the community, leaving \$2,075 to be funded.
