TGUP, in partnership with Kiini Sustainable Initiative, will build two sets of latrines at the Kiahuko Primary School. The school currently has 12 staff and 454 students, of which there are 222 girls, and 232 boys.

The latrines are leaking, near collapse, and labeled a hazard by the county health authorities. This project will construct two buildings, each containing 4 stalls. The staff will share the latrines with the students. Each building will also include a sink for hand washing. Girls often miss school during their period when the latrines are in such deplorable shape.

This is one of 8 projects that TGUP will undertake at the Kiahuko Primary School. The other projects include a new 28'x28' classroom, a new 30'x15' kitchen, cooking jikos for the kitchen, piping water in from the nearby water main, fixing water tanks, a playground, and installing electricity to the entire school.

The structures will include extra foundation support as the soil is considered 'black cotton', and not as stable as clay soil.

The community and school will contribute \$1,000 in labor towards this project.
