Latrines for Kihuyo Secondary School Nyeri, Kenya

Kihuyo Mixed Day Secondary School Latrines

Project Location:

Nyeri, Kenya

NGO Partner:

Kiini Sustainable Initiative (KISI). TGUP has completed more than 20 projects in partnership with KISI, including classrooms, latrines, and playgrounds.

Project Cost:

\$6,000

Needs Assessment:

- * 170 students and 10 staff share two latrines that are near collapse.
- * Girls often skip school because of the poor state of the latrines and the absence of a handwashing area.



TGUP, in partnership with Kiini Sustainable Initiative, will build a set of 4 latrines for the 170 students and 10 teachers at the Kihuyo Mixed Day Secondary School in Nyeri county. The school's enrollment is expected to increase, based on the number of students at feeder schools who are scheduled to matriculate in coming years.

This project will provide two private latrines for boys and two for girls, along with a sink for washing. The latrines will also be shared by the teachers and staff, whose latrines are almost saturated.

The local population is made up of casual workers who often find seasonal work at the surrounding large farm.

The school is also in need of classroom repairs a kitchen, dining area, water catchment, electricity, science lab and play equipment.

The budget for this project is as follows:
