La Pitilla, located in the mountains north of Managua, Nicaragua

Needs Assessment:

- The metal railings will prevent children from falling off the deck and stairs.
- The solar lights will provide electricity.
- Supplies include: a white board, bookshelves and books.



TGUP, in partnership with Seeds of Learning, just finished the construction of a new classroom for the growing community of La Pitilla. The local school only had one small classroom made from an aluminum shed. The shed only held 28 students but there are many more in the community who will attend with a new larger classroom.

Now that the classroom is finished, they are in need of three small additional projects: (1) railings along the outside deck and stairs to prevent children from falling, (2) solar panels and interior lights to provide electricity, and (3) supplies including a white board, bookshelves and books. The school already has desks and chairs.

The community also funded the installation of latrines for the new classroom and is contributing labor to finish the project.
