Project Summary La Pitilla Classroom and Community Center Nicaragua





TGUP, in partnership with Seeds of Learning, will fund the construction of a new classroom for the growing community of La Pitilla. The local school currently only has one small classroom made from an aluminum shed. The shed only holds 28 students but there are many more in the community who will attend with a new larger classroom.

Due to the open construction of the building, the children are currently exposed to all weather elements: rain, wind and heat. La Pitilla is so remote that there are no roads and all supplies will be brought in via horseback or ox cart. The new 18' x 30' classroom will have a concrete floor and walls.

The community will contribute 20% of the total cost of the project in the form of labor. After school, the classroom will be used for community events, education and as a shelter during extreme weather.
