PROJECT NAME:

Rif Library Project, Eljadida
High School Kassita, Morocco

PROJECT SUMMARY:

Provide books in English, for an English Library, located in northeastern Morocco at the Eljadida High School. This

project is based in one of the most under-resourced regions in the Amazigh community. The project will fund the purchase and shipping of these books to support English literacy programs at the high school.

PROJECT PARTNERS:

The Global Uplift Project (TGUP) helps American students and individuals build classrooms and other infrastructure projects in the developing world from donations as small as one dollar (hence its name). Since its founding in 2007, TGUP has completed more than 120 such projects in 15 countries in Asia, Central America, and Africa. TGUP is an IRS registered 501c3 nonprofit.

OliveSeed/Morocco Library Project (MLP) has been developing English libraries in under-resourced communities of Morocco since January 2014. MLP works closely with English teachers in these communities to understand the context and need of the local student population and then curates a library collection that is tailored to that location. We send high-quality fiction and nonfiction literature in all genres and reading levels. Most of these libraries are at public high schools, a few others, developed in partnership with Peace Corps volunteers, are at youth centers.

One of our themes at MLP is to inspire interest in STEM and environmental topics. We offer books on science, technology, and nature, and we encourage this with the partner teacher. For example, we send books such as the picture-rich DK Eyewitness nature

series; *The Way Things Work*; Smithsonian or National Geographic visual encyclopedias on science, space and inventions; books on climate; and biographies of inspiring people in STEM, such as *Hidden Figures*, *Girls Think of Everything*, *The Boy Who Harnessed the Wind*; and young reader biographies from Steve Jobs to Wangari Maathai. Generally, 15 to 20 percent of the books we send are of this genre, unless the teacher has an interest for more.

MLP is a program of Oliveseed.org, a 501c3 based in Palo Alto, California, whose mission is to inspire and empower the next generation of global citizens through literacy programs and environmental education. Most of the books MLP sends are purchased new through Books Inc., an independent bookstore in the San Francisco Bay Area and Oliveseed partner. Books Inc. gives MLP a generous educator's discount on all books bought for Morocco, and their customers also purchase books to send from our wish lists.

ABOUT THE COMMUNITY AND PROJECT:

The Eljadida High School is a public school in a town called Kassita, which is located in the Driouach region, in the province of Nador. This area is part of the Rif region in northeastern Morocco. Prior to the building of the Eljadida High School there was only one school in Kassita which educated both middle and high school levels. The school opened in 2017, and was built with a library, which stands empty of books (see photo of room with tables, chairs but no books).



Currently, there are 429 students divided into Common Core level (128), First Baccalaureate level (159), and Second Baccalaureate level (142). The schools offer a variety of educational programming, including physics, life sciences, human sciences, grammar and language classes.

The student ages range from 14 to 19, and 80% of students come from remote locations – surrounding rural and mountain areas that don't have middle schools. Thus, Kassita is the destination for many students who come by school bus. Depending on the distance, some of these buses come early in the morning and do not return home until after the last class in the late afternoon. This means some students (mostly girls) have to stay within school walls the whole day, including lunch period. Having books in the library will provide the students with additional educational opportunities along with social activities (English book clubs) and a safe, quiet place to study.

ANTICIPATED BENEFITS:

We believe this project will help bring literacy, love of learning, and greater breadth of knowledge to a new generation in Morocco. Our goal is for young people to be not just readers, but also critical thinkers and leaders. Our hope is that this next generation will have the literacy, knowledge, confidence, and connections to make a positive impact on the world.

PRIMARY BENEFICIARIES:

The students of Eljadida High School. In many of our current library locations around

Morocco (over 35 and growing), students have stepped up and taken the lead by learning how to manage their own English clubs, writing book reviews and essays, or becoming motivated on environmental issues, even presenting to classes and conducting interviews on nature conservancy.
