Needs Assessment:

- The school does not have any books for the library.
- * 80% of the school's 429 students come from remote locations and spend long hours at school. This means some students (mostly girls) have to stay within school walls the whole day, including lunch period. The library will provide them a place to explore books and learn.



OliveSeed/Morocco Library Project (MLP) has been developing English libraries in under-resourced communities of Morocco since January 2014. MLP works closely with English teachers in these communities to understand the context and need of the local student population and then curates a library collection that is tailored to that location. We send high-quality fiction and nonfiction literature in all genres and reading levels. Most of these libraries are at public high schools, a few others, developed in partnership with Peace Corps volunteers, are at youth centers. To date, they have funded close to 40 libraries in Morocco.

TGUP will partner with MLP to furnish the Eljadida High School with close to 200 books. The school has a dedicated library room but currently does not have any books. Having books in the library will provide the students with additional educational opportunities along with social activities (English book clubs) and a safe, quiet place to study.
