Established in 1993 in the Dang district of mid-western Nepal, Nepal Women Community Service Center (NWCS) is the first women specific non-government organization in the Rapti Zone. Their goal is to provide support through multiple channels to uplift, educate and empower women to obtain equal status to men.

This is accomplished through leadership development, gender awareness training, support of victims of conflict, micro finance programs and skills development.

Their micro finance programs promotes economic and social empowerment to disadvantaged, abused and deprived women.

In partnership with another TGUP's NGO partner, Little Sisters Fund, NWCS selects girls who would otherwise not go to school and supports them and their families so the girls can complete their schooling. This support includes scholarships, personal and health management and mentorship programs.
