Pliken



Pliken is a division of East Africa Children's Hope (EACH). EACH's mission is to support vulnerable and orphaned children in East Africa by providing access to primary, secondary and post-secondary education, with a particular emphasis on supporting charitable organizations led by local East Africans.

Pliken was established in 2016 as a non-governmental organization with the goal of addressing poverty in disadvantaged communities.

The founder was motivated by a deep concern for teenage girls who were forced to leave school because of early pregnancies, lack of access to feminine hygiene products, and other challenges. In impoverished communities, girls often drop out of school and engage in risky behaviors, jeopardizing their health and future. These circumstances result in food insecurity and prevent children from attending school due to lack of funds. Pliken strives to uplift these women through mentorship programs and send their children to school with confidence to better themselves.
