Project Summary:

Provide clothing to children of families in the San Francisco Bay Area living in RVs.

Project Need:

Many families are living in RVs on the streets of Palo Alto and Mountain View. The children attend local schools, but new clothing is a luxury that most cannot afford.

Project Cost:

There was no cost to TGUP as the clothing was donated, and KSP volunteers carried out the distribution.



Fourteen large grocery sacks of barely used clothing were donated to TGUP with the request that they be given to children who needed them.

KSP works with families in Palo Alto and Mountain View, in the San Francisco Bay Area, that live in Recreational Vehicles (RVs) as they cannot afford the high cost of renting a home in the area.

The children attend local schools, and the families participate in the life of the community, but many are hourly workers and after paying for food, gas, and other expenses there is very little left over for luxuries or clothing. KSP has a network of volunteers, including people who live in RVs, so they knew which children most needed new clothing.

Fifty children have been outfitted with like-new summer clothes, and back-to-school outfits that will really help the students to fit in well with their classmates. They will be more comfortable in school, and will therefore do better in their classes.
