

RIAMUKURWE PRY AND JS SCHOOL.

The school was started in 1957 in the present location of Micha village at Riamukurwe, Nyeri town constituency in Nyeri County. It is a Government public primary and Junior school. The school has a Total population of 570 Learners from PP1 to Grade 9. (274boys and 296 girls).

The school serve the entire Riamukurwe area and Skuta area and its environment. The school has double streams in all classes except grade1. The school is only funded by the Kenya Government which is not sufficient. It has 26 teachers who are all employees of the Kenya Government. The school also serve children from four children homes. Namely: Huruma children home, Thunguma Rehabilitation center, Tumaini children home, and German children home. All of which are within our vicinity.

The school lacks essential infrastructures like adequate classroom, some of which have worn-out floors , leaners lockers and seats and Latrines, Teachers tables and chairs that are dilapidated. We are currently improving the school environment in form of beautification. The whole school needs painting to make it appealing. Books are in the ratio of 1book to 3 learners. Science and computer labs facilities are lacking in our school. With all these challenges, the Learners have been posting good performance. With your assistance we promise to work even harder. The school is in need of lockers and chairs for grade 9, lab equipment and latrines. The school has a well maintained playground but lack playground equipment's bearing it serves the children homes around.

The community surrounding the school are mainly casual labourers who live in communal villages who live in highly concentrated areas for survival and usually survive in one meal per day.
