Project Need:

The school does not have any playground equipment at all. The students just run around in a dirt field for exercise and play.

\$1,260



The Global Uplift Project, in partnership with the Little Sisters Fund, will help fund the construction and installation of playground equipment for the Sankhadevi Secondary School in Majhimtar, Nepal. The school population is comprised of a mix of castes including 'untouchables' (Dalit), Brahmin, Janajati, and Chhetri.

There are 546 students from nursery school to 12th grade supported by a very dedicated staff of 26 people. The school has a large area sufficient in size to support the playground equipment. Included in this project will be 2 slides, a swing with 4 seats, 2 seesaws, and a trampoline. Students who are allowed to play show increased performance in academics and health.

The total cost is \$2,520 but the school and community are contributing 50% leaving \$1,260 for TGUP to fund. This is a student-led initiative.
