


TGUP Project Summary

Disaster relief for the TGUP sewing center and seamstresses.

Nepal Women **Community Service** Center (NWCSC)


Project Cost:

\$2,000

Needs Assessment:

- The sewing center roof collapsed due to falling masonry from an adjoining construction project.
- The damage has caused the center to become unusable.
- The seamstresses have no other source of income while the center is being repaired.

TGUP, in partnership with the Nepal Women's Community Service Center (NWCSC), will support the 40 seamstresses who work at the *Save a Girl* Sewing Center in Dang. \$1,000 will go towards funding the production of 5,000 masks and \$1,000 will go towards general support of the seamstresses.

With the onset of Covid, the sewing center has been unable to sell their merchandise at the local markets. This has greatly reduced the income that otherwise would support the seamstresses who work at the sewing center. These women all come from the Dalit 'untouchable' caste and/or were abandoned or abused.

The seamstresses will work from home to make the masks and will be given food and other necessities, until the center is repaired, and they are back at work full time.
