TGUP, in partnership with KISI, will fund the installation of 6 pit latrines for students at the Shining Star primary school in rural Nyeri county. The existing 3 latrines are at risk of collapse and lead to girls skipping school during their menstrual cycle. All 269 students currently share the 3 latrines in the above photo.

TGUP has previously funded many sets of latrines for other schools in the country. This project will include a new building comprised of 6 private latrines and a washing station.

The student population had risen to 450 but due to lack of adequate facilities, in particular classrooms and latrines as required by the Ministry of Education and Public Health, the student population has been reduced to 250. TGUP is currently in the process of building a new classroom to address this problem and hopes to raise funds to refurbish the playground and courtyard.
