

Unjiru Primary School Electricity

Unjiru Primary School is a Mixed day public primary school established in **1974** and located in **Icuga Sub-location, Konyu Location, Mathira West Sub-county, Nyeri County, Kenya**. The school serves a total population of 406 **learners**, comprising of 236 **Girls** and 170 **boys** and **17 teachers**.

The school has **13 classrooms**, which provide learning spaces for pupils from lower, upper primary and Junior Secondary. The lacks electricity in their classrooms and this hinders concentration especially during morning hours when the weather is foggy. With provision of electricity the learners will be able to make use of time especially morning hours when their minds is fresh. Majority of parents are locals who practice mixed farming in a small way.
